TOURIST AND INSTITUTIONAL VISITS



- **Lima city**

The capital of Peru is famous for its colonial architecture of the Historic Center and the legacy of pre-Hispanic cultures, as well as for its gastronomy and districts.



- **Callao**

It was founded by Spanish colonizers in 1537, only two years after Lima (1535). It soon became the main port for Spanish trade in the Pacific



- **Pachacamac**

Considered an oracle capable of predicting the future and controlling Earth's rotation, for more than a thousand years it was the main sanctuary of the central coast. In those times, their temples were visited by crowds of pilgrims.



- **Lurín**

One of the 43 districts of the providence of Lima, and an almost 109 km long river, with fertile valleys suitable for agriculture and also beaches. The most important tourist attraction in the area is Pachacamac.
